## Clearview Water Supply Agency Pump Station Monthly Operations Report December 2023

## 1. Emergency Call Out Responses at the Pump Station

We had no afterhours call outs for the month of December.

## 2. Pump Station Site

- General housekeeping and landscaping.
- We performed a PS 1&2 shutdown test requiring us to rely solely on the CV pump station. We ran the station maintaining roughly 51-55ft of elevation in the reservoir.

## 3. Routine Maintenance

- We completed all the weekly reads and safety inspections to include the monthly fire extinguisher inspections.
- Exercised pumps 3 and 4, the fixed speed pumps for around 20 minutes each.
- Replaced leaking braided hose that feeds suction water to the mechanical seal on pump 3.
- Performed annual air compressor service as well as the quarterly crane inspection. No deficiencies or issues were found.
- The electrical group continued their preventative maintenance schedule at the pump station.

## 4. Average Set Point for Pumping Activity

 During December our flows ranged from 8.0-14MDG. This number is out of normal range for this time of year based on the PS 1 & 2 test we performed relying on only CV water feeding the southeastern portion of Alderwood.

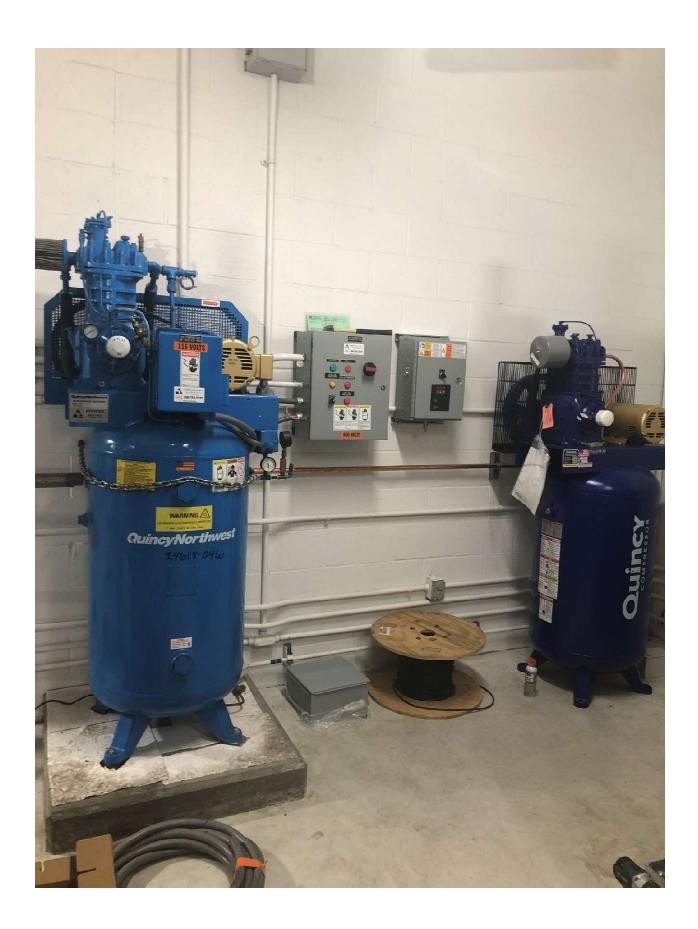
