OVERVIEW

The Alderwood Water & Wastewater District owns and operates the Picnic Point Wastewater Treatment Facility. Over time, certain mechanical, electrical and process components wear and need replacement. This project will replace or repair existing equipment at the Headworks (HW), Solids Handling Building (SHB). This project will also upgrade and install new valves in the aeration system to allow for better control of air within the aeration basins.

- HW Odor Control Fans and Ducting
- Dryer Heat exchanger
- Solids Dryer
- Aeration Basin Control Valves

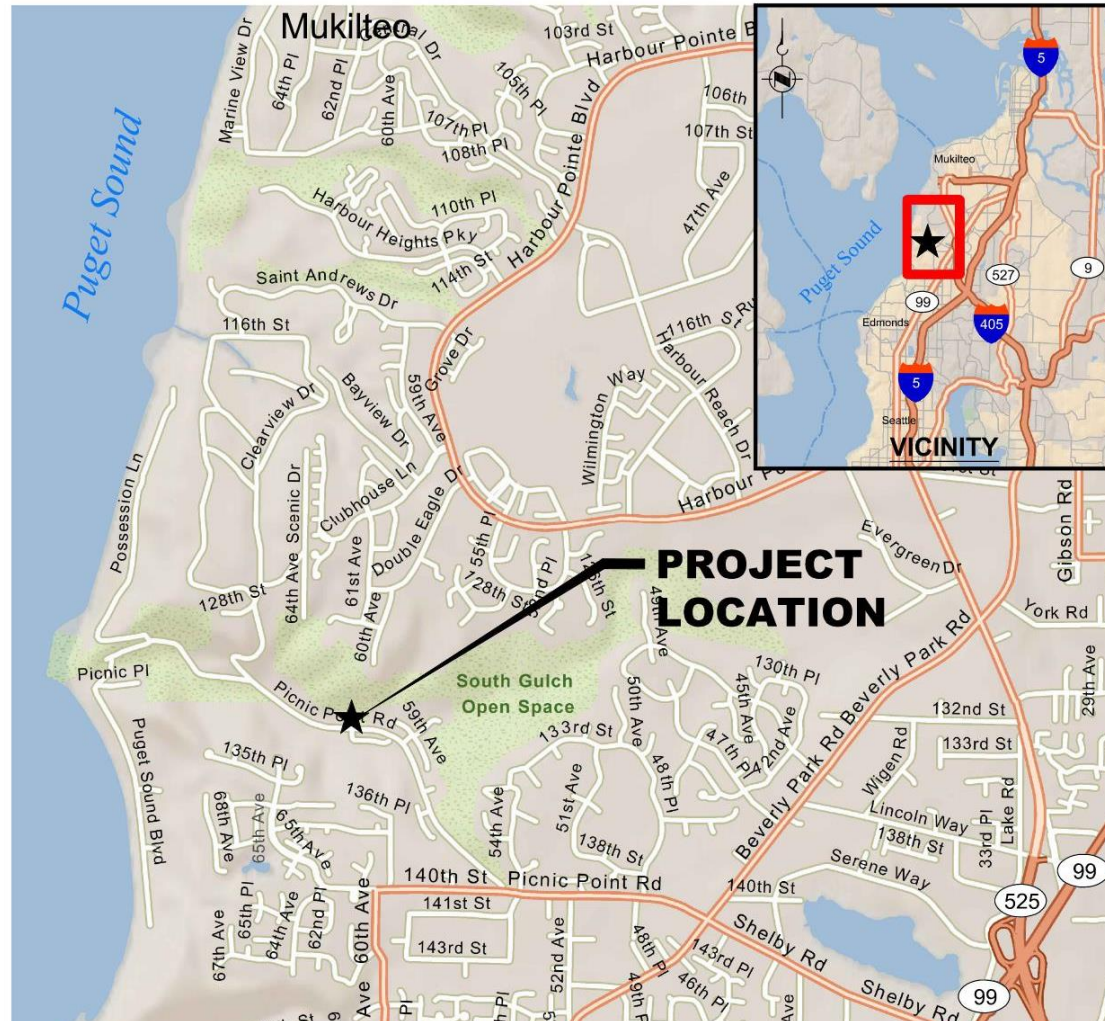
