



RESERVOIRS 2 & 3 RECOATING PROJECT (AWWD PROJECT #W1401) OCTOBER 2020 PROJECT UPDATE



OVERVIEW

AWWD is repainting Reservoirs 2 and 3 located immediately behind the Administration Building. The existing paint is peeling and is no longer adequately protecting the steel walls and roof against corrosion. The new coatings will last up to 30 years, provide protection of the structure for increased service life, and improve the look of the tanks.

What do Reservoirs do?

Reservoirs 2 and 3 provide temporary storage for drinking water.

- ✓ Construction Start: June 12, 2019
- ✓ Construction Completion: November 2020
- ✓ Normal Daytime Work Hours: 7am-7pm
- ✓ Contractor will work Monday through Friday and some weekends as needed.

Construction is progressing ahead of schedule. Project has reached substantial completion with only touch up and repair work remaining.



Budget

Project is within budget.



SCOPE OF WORK

- ✓ Fully enclose reservoirs to contain airborne dust and paint materials
- ✓ Prepare steel surfaces by pressure washing and abrasive blasting
- ✓ Apply three layers of paint including primer (zinc epoxy), intermediate coat (epoxy), and top coat (polysiloxane)
- ✓ Remove enclosures and equipment and clean up site

IMPACTS

- ✓ Increased noise in the area throughout construction
- ✓ Increased traffic for deliveries of supplies and equipment to site
- ✓ No disruptions to water or sewer service anticipated
- ✓ “Advance notice will be provided regarding any traffic or water service disruptions, unless an emergency arises.”

PROJECT LOCATION



All construction activity will take place on-site at the AWWWD Reservoirs 2 and 3 site. Construction is progressing on schedule and no traffic interruptions are anticipated.
